- * If students have taken one course from the Department (Semester 1 or 2), such course will be counted as a major course to which they are assigned after Year 1. **BSocSc (Hons) in Sociology students are advised to take *SOCI1005 Invitation to Sociology* in the second semester of Year 1.** SOCI1005 is a required course. Students who have taken SOCI1005 in Year 1 should take 3 units GE Distribution course in Sem 1 of Year 2.

- ^ Students are required to take a total of 33 units of major elective courses. The requirements are as follow: a) 6 units from Level 1 or 2, b) 27 units from Level 3 or 4 of which at least 9 units should be selected from Level 3 and 12 units from Level 4.
- @ Students are required to take two different Physical Education activities, one activity in Semester 1 and another activity in Semester 2.
- % Students are required to take one three-unit course from each of the 4 Faculty/School/Academy combinations outside of their own Faculties/Schools/Academy. One of these 4 courses may be an interdisciplinary course, which will be listed for two (or more) areas of learning. Students have to decide which area (outside of their own Faculty/School/Academy) they would like the courses to fulfil.
- & In addition to 38 units GE requirements, student may take additional GE courses in any categories to fulfil Free Elective requirement but only a max. of 6 units will be counted towards fulfillment of Free Elective requirement
