Arrangements of Double-Counting GE Capstone Courses Offered by the Sociology Programmes

The Sociology Programmes offers two GE Capstone courses in AY2025/2026. They are:

- (1) GCAP3156 Taste, Environment and Technology: Food as a Lens
- (2) GCAP3157 Leisure and Well-Being: Coping with Stress

<u>Sociology Major</u>: The above GE Capstone courses can be <u>double-counted towards</u> SOSC 3005 Community and Civic Engagement*. Students who would like to double-count any of the two GE Capstone courses have to take <u>any Sociology Major Elective</u> course as a replacement course to make up for the outstanding three units to fulfill the graduation requirements.

<u>Sociology Minor</u>: The above GE Capstone courses can be <u>double-counted towards a Level-3 / Level-4 Sociology Elective course</u>. Students who would like to double-count any of the two GE Capstone courses can take <u>any Free Elective course</u> as a <u>replacement course</u> to make up for the outstanding three units to fulfill the graduation requirements.

LST-DD and PSHET-DD: The above GE Capstone courses *cannot be double-counted* towards SOSC 3005 Community and Civic Engagement.

* Students of the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences are required to take either (i) SOSC 3005 Community and Civic Engagement (three units) or (ii) SOSC 3006 Global Outreach (three units) as the fulfilment of Experiential Learning in Action, which is one of the two components of the Social Sciences Common Core.
