^ Students are required to take a total of 36 units of major elective courses. The requirements are as follows: a) 9 units of Level 2 courses, b) 27 units of Level 3 or 4 courses, of which at least 9 units of Level 3 courses and 12 units of Level 4 courses.

@ The Department offers three GE Capstone courses, including GCAP3156 (Taste, Environment, and Technology: Food as a Lens), GCAP3157 (Leisure and Well-Being), and GCAP3165 (Understanding Society through Independent Inquiry). Students can double-count any one of the three courses as SOSC3005 Community and Civic Engagement and take a Sociology Major Elective course as a replacement course to fulfill the graduation requirements.
